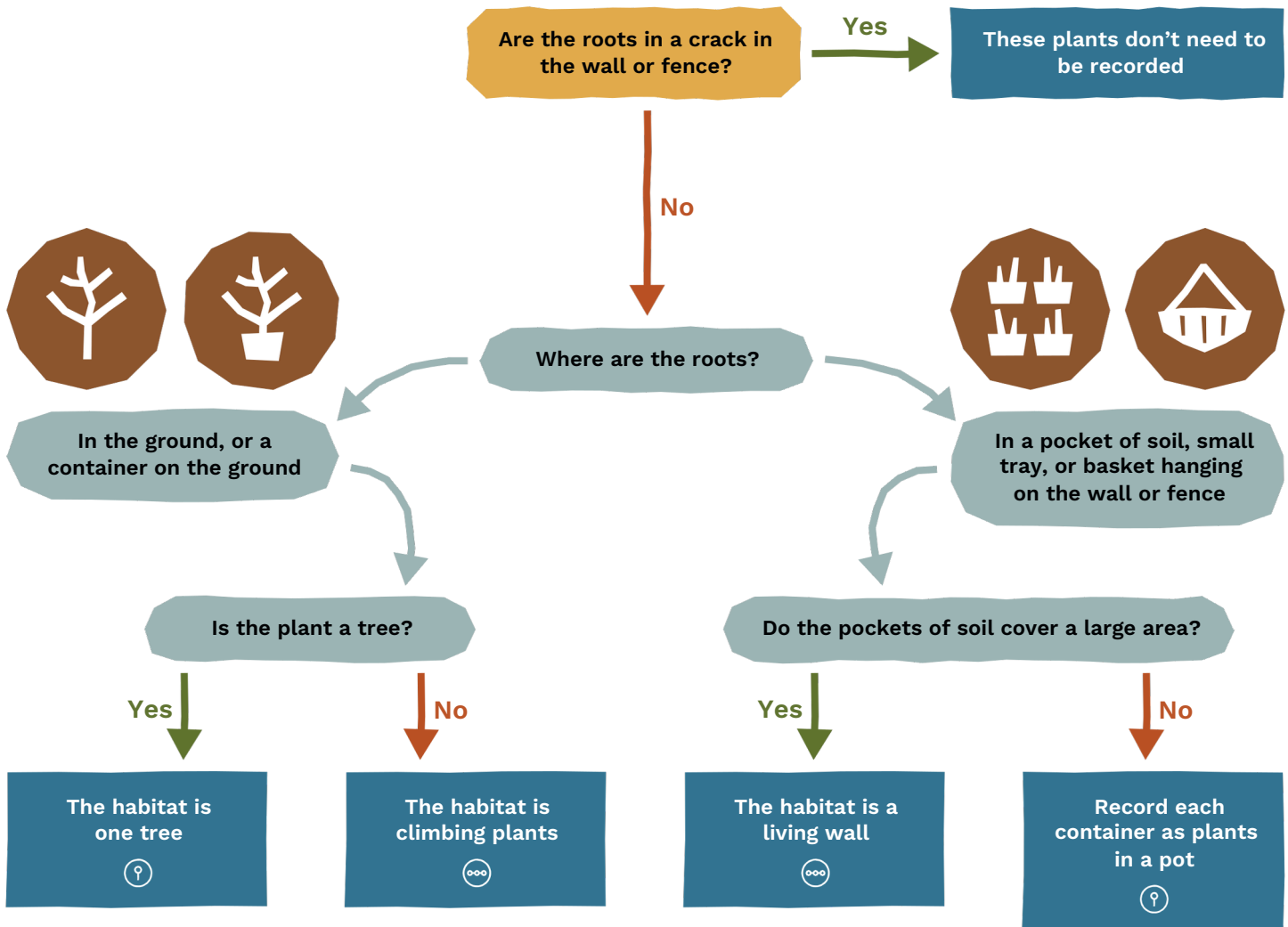
Part one: Look around your site for vertical features like walls, fences and sheds. Map all the vertical features on your site and identify what they are made from.

The habitat is a metal fence 

The habitat is a wooden fence. This includes fences, sheds, and wooden plant supports. 

Part two: Follow the plant's stem down to its roots. If the plant doesn't have a stem, like moss, you don't need to map these plants.



Green roofs 

If you have a building, shed, bike park or similar where the roof has plants on it (planted into gravel or soil, not in pots), you can add it to the map as a green roof.
